

CREDIT RECOGNITION

Our credit system is based on the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), which provides common procedures to assure academic recognition of studies with other ECTS institutions. Recognition of credits earned in mobility follows ECTS principles in conformity with the European University Charter.

The Transcript of Records issued by foreign institutions are evaluated and compared to the Learning Agreement signed by all parties before/during the student's departure.

This is done to aid student's academic progression.

The office of Tutorage determines and certifies the exact amount of credits to allocate to the student's official study record and Diploma Supplement.

Some variation may occur between Home and Host institution credit allocation when fractions of credits are assigned - we do not recognize fractions of credits.

To establish corresponding grading values, we follow guidelines set by the European Commission ECTS Users' Guide.
